*Camp Friendship meets at the Friendship Centre at HighPoint, which is owned & operated by the Institute for Community. The IFC is a 501 c3 non-profit organization.

The health & safety of our families & staff continues to be our top priority. We are adhering to the Center for Disease Control (CDC), State of Illinois, & Department of Health & Human Services (IDHS) guidelines for this summer.

Camp will look drastically different this year. We can accept a maximum of 50 campers. They will be broken down, by age group, into groups of 10. Each group will have 1 counselor with them & will have a home base in the facility where they will play games, do crafts, and eat lunch/snack. We will use other areas of the campus (gym, Freindship Square, VB/Sand Court, & Trail). We can still provide a Fun & Safe Place for your children this summer. CAMP SESSIONS

Camp Friendship Summer Camps are conducted in ten-one week sessions. The camps are held Monday – Friday of each week in the session. Camp hours are 9:00am – 4:30pm daily. Early & Late Childcare is available from 7:00am – 9:00am & 4:30pm – 6:00pm.

SCHEDULE

All camps will be held Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 4:30pm. Early/Late Childcare is available 7:00am – 9:00am/4:30pm – 6:00pm for an additional fee. Camp Counselors will not be available after 6:00pm. **Charge for pick-up after 6:00pm is \$1.00 per minute due the following day at drop-off.**

Daily health screening: Everyone that enters Camp will have their temperature taken & be asked 3 simple health questions. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 will be asked to leave. Parents/Guardians will be required to sign their child(ren) in and out each day of the camp. Parents/Guardians must provide a note if their children are to be picked up by anyone other than themselves. All persons other than parents/guardians authorized to pick up your child must be listed on the registration form. For your child's protection, we reserve the right to request identification from anyone picking up a child.

CAMP ELECTIVES



An Academic Enrichment Program is available to our campers for an additional charge. Info & pricing will be available 5/30. Children are walked to and from their prospective program by a camp counselor. For more information contact Liz Guse at lguse@instituteformcommunity.org

Registration

Registration is accepted on a first come-first served basis. The maximum enrollment for each camp session is 50 campers. **We will be accepting Full Time Enrollments only this year. Camp spots will be reserved when registration and 1st payment is received.** A waiting list will be kept in case of a drop in enrollment or non-payment of fees.

There are three payment options this year. You may 1) Pay in full at registration, 2) Pay 50% at registration with the other 50% due by July 15th 3) Pay weekly (payment due one week prior to the session start date). Camp Enrollment is not guaranteed until payment is received.

WHAT ALL CAMPER SHOULD BRING

All campers should bring a bag packed with sunscreen, water bottle, book to read and any other necessary items. In addition, all children **MUST** wear non-marking tennis shoes (no sandals). Children not having the appropriate shoes will not be allowed to participate in gymnasium activities.

****Lunch and an afternoon snack is provided each day (Menu available on June 1st).** We do have a concession stand here on site. Students are not allowed to go during lunch however they are allowed to go during snack time (4p.m.-4:30pm.) Items range in price from \$.50-\$2.00. I will have a price sheet available the first week of camp. We do limit each camper to 2 items per day.

Electronics Policy: No electronics allowed (including cell phones).
